In celebration of the Ohio Bicentennial, this exhibition of color 360-degree photographs showcases many of the unique and important cities, towns, and villages throughout the state of Ohio. This is a collection of photographs taken by Schiff and includes Tall Stacks, Dayton Air Force Museum, Ash Cave in Hocking Hills, and a lot more. Schiff used a Hulcherama 360 Panoramic Camera. There will be a reception on March 30 from 2:00, at Sharon Woods, in the Sharon Centre Auditorium. The National Wildlife Federation has certified Mr. Eckel's yard as a mini refuge, based on his conscientious planning, landscaping and gardening, providing wildlife with food, water and cover.
