Upcoming Club Exhibition Venues

We have **two** exhibitions coming up in September.

One (for Black & White) **Starbuck's Coffeeshouse** in Ft. Thomas on Grand Ave. and one (for Color) at **Scribbles Coffeeshouse** in Alexandria Ky. The images for both locations

must be framed with glass and a wire hanger attached to the frame.

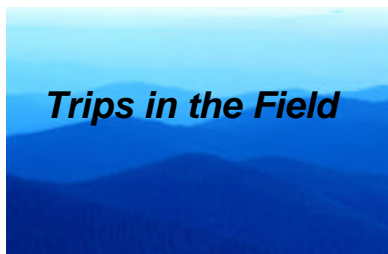
For Starbucks (B&W) Prints John Devine and Margie Stigler will be collecting the framed prints during the August meetings. John and Margie will deliver the prints for hanging by Richard Hamilton on Friday September 5th. **There will be an artists' reception on Friday September 12th from 7 to 9 p.m. with music provided by Steve Barrone, a jazz guitarist.** Club members may bring hors d'oeuvres or other snack items (excluding coffee and cookies and pastries which Starbucks sells at the coffeehouse). Prints must be 8 x 10 or larger. We encourage a range of sizes. The exhibit will be hung until Friday October 3rd. and cannot be removed during the exhibit. If any maker wishes to sell their exhibited work, place cards with your name, address, telephone no. and e-mail address on the picture frames. No attachments to the coffeehouse walls will be permitted. So get busy and generate those B&W prints. Starbucks seems to be a “happening place” always full of people and lively conversation.

The exhibit at **Scribbles** is for color prints. Prints can be dropped off at either meeting in August. The exhibit

will run for the month of September. Bob Ihrig will hang the prints on Saturday, August 30th (Bob could use a helper for that day). **We will have a reception on Saturday, September 6th.** Prints can be sold, but it is the responsibility of the owners to take care of this. As with Starbuck's we suggest a business card with the price and contact information placed on the bottom of the print. I think it should be easy to slide a card between the frame and glass (or a piece of tape on the glass). Contributors should do this ahead of time. Scribbles is located at 18 East Main in Alexandria.

Directions: Travel about five and one half miles south on U.S. 27 (Alexandria Pike) from the library. You will see a Shell gas station on the left. Turn left at the third traffic light past the Shell station (rt. 10) Go about 1/4 mile on rt. 10 (Main Street). Scribbles will be on the left, across the street from the court house.

Virginia Cox and I talked to Ron Dunham, a local photographer from Kentucky, who has a new gallery in Covington. He would be amenable to a club exhibition sometime in the future. I am still trying to get into the exhibition space at NKU and or at Clermont College in Batavia Ohio.



Infrared Field Trip

Join us for a great day of shooting infrared film. On Saturday, August 23rd at 10:00 a.m. we'll meet at Caesar's Creek State Park at Pioneer Village. There will be some experts on hand, so even if you've never shot this type of film before, you should end up with good exposures - the composition is,

of course, in the eye of the beholder! With infrared photography, a bright sunny day is ideal for shooting. Since this field trip is weather dependent, watch the Tri-State list-serve that Saturday morning as notification will be placed there if a cancellation is necessary.

Caesar's Creek State Park is at 8570 East S.R. 73 in Waynesville, OH. 45068-9719, phone is (513) 897-3055 From Cincinnati, Ohio: I-71 North to State Route 73. Turn Left on State Route 73, park entrance is approximately 6 miles on the right.

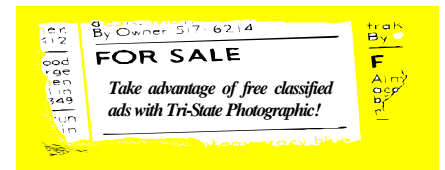
