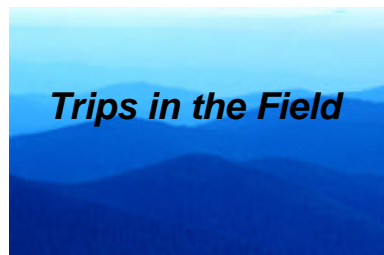
#### More Scribbles!

Afterwards we got to shoot little frogs (that doesn't sound

good, does it?) sitting on and peaking up from duckweed in a pond near the visitor's center. Some of our group said that Caesar's Creek is a great place to come in winter for snow shots, so keep that in mind, Tri-Staters!

#### Second Annual Photo Weekend In Cincinnati

**Friday October 24 to Sunday, October 26, 2003**

Get your creative juices flowing for an autumn weekend, in an urban setting! Join your friends and fellow photographers for some friendly competition around the Tristate area of Ohio, Kentucky and Indiana. This contest is open to photographers of all levels, so spread the word!

#### Schedule:

**Friday, October 24, 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.** Register and pick up rules, regulations, and categories at the Cold Spring Branch of the Campbell County Public Library (3920 Alexandria Pike, Cold Spring, Kentucky); use the side entrance, around the right side of the library.

**Friday 6:00 p.m. to Saturday at 6:00 p.m.** The competition begins at 6:00 Friday night. Shoot for the categories

anywhere inside the I-275 beltway—shoot only one roll of film.

**Saturday, October 25.** Return your one roll of E6slide film to the Erlanger Branch of the Kenton County Public Library (401 Kenton Lands Drive, Erlanger, Kentucky), between 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.

**Sunday, October 26, Erlanger Branch of the Kenton County Public Library.** Pick up your slides at 1:00 p.m. Bring your light boxes and loupes to the library; there will be room for you to review your slides there. Select the slides you wish to enter in the competition and return them by 2:00 p.m. Winning slides will be shown and awards given at 3:00 p.m.

**Cost: \$20 Early Registration. Pre-register by October 4.** Mail the registration form along with your check (made payable to Tristate Photographic Society) to Mary Nemeth at 4589 Middlecourt Drive, Batavia, Ohio 45103. Registration at the door is \$25. You must register Friday evening, as noted above—there is no Saturday registration.

**Directions:** From AA Highway, take the exit for U. S. Rt. 27 north (which is also Alexandria Pike) and go approximately 2.0 miles. The Cold Spring Library is on the left. From I-275, take exit 74, towards Alexandria/U. S. Rt. 27 south (which is also Alexandria Pike). From the first traffic light at the entrance to Northern Kentucky University (Nunn Drive), go approximately one mile. The Cold Spring Library is on the right.

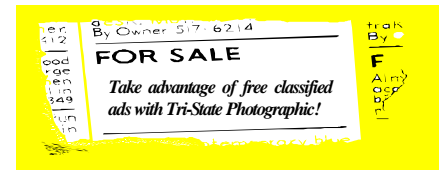
