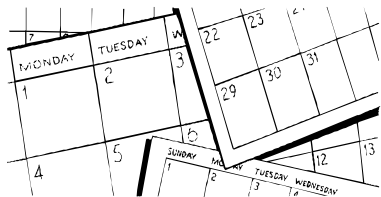
The featured speaker will be Brian Wheeler, who is THE authority on Raptors in this area. He has written a book about Raptors, and will be signing his book after the presentation.

RIVER DOWNS RACE TRACK FIELD TRIP ON 8/14/04

15 of our members and a couple of guests joined Peter Defoe of the River Downs staff for our field trip on Saturday, August 14, 2004. The weather cooperated this time, (after the rain out on 7/31/04), and we enjoyed delightfully sunny skies and mellow temperatures. Varied opportunities were afforded for capturing images of the many stages of horseracing, from early morning training runs for "new" horses at track side, to a tour on a tractor drawn tram through the barn area, to a tour of the jockey's dressing rooms (male & female), and close up access to the 5th race which was conducted on the turf track.

Thanks to Peter Defoe for all the work in getting this outing arranged.

Raptor, Inc. Sept. 25

Jeff Hayes, President of **Raptor, Inc.** has graciously agreed to allow our members to visit their facility located on the west end of Winton Woods on September 25. Jeff will make the birds available, by placing them on perches so that we can photograph them. He has many "program birds", which they use at schools and other facilities for educational purposes. He does give one caveat-----Any photographs which we take cannot be sold, since their licensing forbids such commercial use. Currently, the population includes the following:

Red Tail Hawk, Barred Owl, Screech

Owl, Peregrine Falcon, Turkey Vulture, Kestrel pair (male and female), and others. That population could change. If they take in any injured raptors, and they can be rehabbed to be released back into the wild, Jeff cannot make them available for photographing.

The facility is next door to the only Covered Bridge located in Hamilton County. So, we have the added benefit of some other interesting subjects.

PARKING /CARPOOLING:

Parking is limited to 10 cars. So, we will meet at the Winton Woods Visitor Center and carpool in 10 cars from there. So, all of you with those big SUV"s, station wagons, and vans, get your chauffeur hats on. The Winton Woods Visitor Center is on the left of Winton Woods as you are heading North on Winton Road. We'll meet there at 8:30 AM and then carpool to Raptor Inc to meet Jeff Hayes at 9AM.

Old Washington, KY - first Saturday in December for their annual Christmas Village transformation.

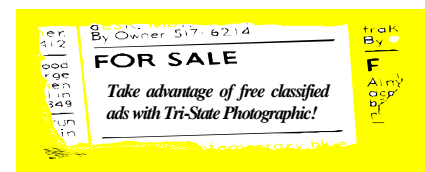
