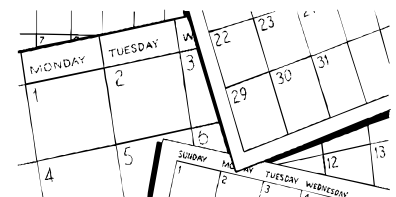

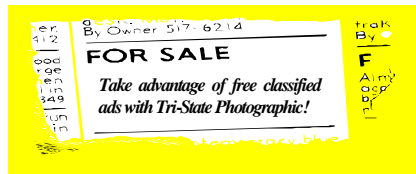
### Upcoming Fieldtrips
