### Old Washington, KY Frontier Christmas December 4th & 5th, 2004

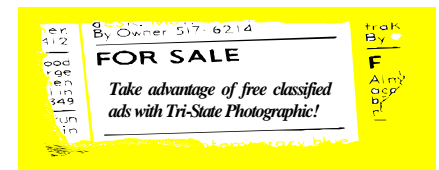
This will be the 37th Annual Event. For more information on this award winning festival call the Washington Log Visitor's Center 606-759-7411.
